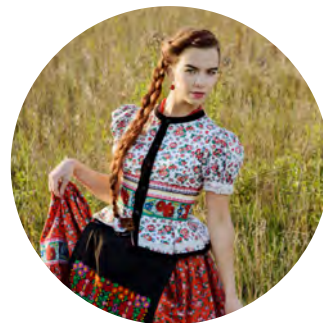

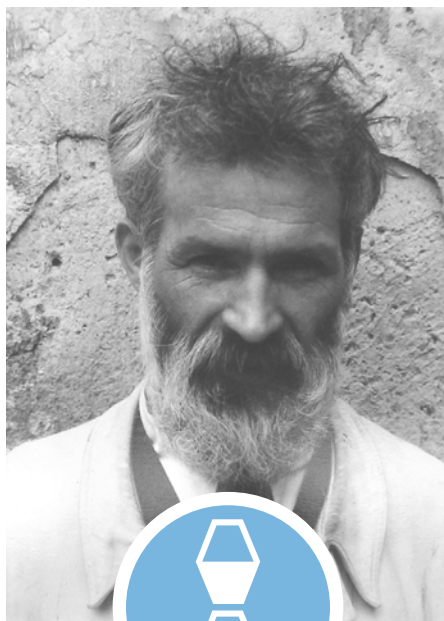

**Vlad Țepeș or
Vlad the Impaler**
(1431 – 1476)

was a Voievode and ruler of Wallachia. As a result of the brutal punishments applied to the enemies, he was nicknamed Vlad Dracula and inspired, four centuries later, Bram Stoker's fictional character in the Dracula novel.

**Constantin Brâncuși**
(1876 – 1957)

was one of the most influential and acclaimed sculptors of the 20th century, best known for his abstract sculptures of ovoid heads and birds in flight. His unique works are displayed in museums all over the world: in New York, Paris, England, Romania.

**George Enescu**
(1881 – 1955)

is considered the most important Romanian musician, best known for "Romanian Rhapsody" orchestral work. In 1958, the "George Enescu Festival" was initiated in his memory and still continues today, being a musical event of international prestige.



Ana Aslan
(1897 – 1988)

was one of the most awarded Romanian researchers, who discovered the anti-aging effects of procaine, thus creating in 1952 the famous "Gerovital H3" formula and later the "Aslavital" formula. "Ana Aslan" is currently a brand for a line of cosmetic products sold in Europe, Asia, USA.

**Nadia Comăneci**
(1961 -)

is the living legend of the gymnastics world, who at the age of 14, became the first gymnast in the Olympic history to be awarded the perfect score of 10.0 at the 1976 Summer Olympics in Montreal.

**Angela Gheorghiu**
(1965 -)

is considered the most glamorous and gifted opera singer of our time, being honoured with important decorations and titles, in Romania and France.

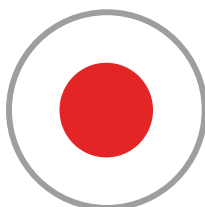

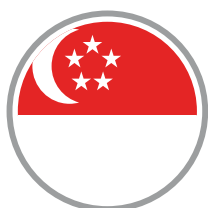

MAJOR CITIES

BUCHAREST

Romania's largest city and capital, once nicknamed "Little Paris", nowadays a restless metropolis during day and night.

Bucharest is a stylish and colorful capital full of beautiful places: interesting museums and cultural edifices, lovely churches and monasteries, great hotels, restaurants, pubs and clubs.

The city is permanently changing, offering a unique urban environment, a spectacular interwar architecture mixed with 21st century buildings of steel and glass.



MAJOR CITIES

SIBIU

The city of Sibiu, appointed as European Capital of Culture in 2007, is a fusion of Romanian, Saxon and Hungarian cultures.

Displaying an interesting blend of architectural styles, the city lays out as a labyrinth of medieval squares, narrow streets, churches and bridges.

Sibiu is primarily loved for its medieval charm, for its cozy restaurants and is surrounded by beautiful landscapes.

Today, it is one of the Romanian cities with the highest level of foreign investments and in 2019 Sibiu Region will be the European Region of Gastronomy.



MAJOR CITIES

CLUJ-NAPOCA

The capital of Transylvania in the medieval times, Cluj-Napoca is today a vibrant university city, hosting both traditional and progressive events. Surnamed "The Silicon Valley of Europe" due to the numerous IT companies that operate here, Cluj-Napoca is definitely worth visiting for its excellent cultural activities, wonderful historical legacy, fine dining and great atmosphere.

According to Huffington Post, Cluj-Napoca is one of the twelve cities that will shake up the art world in the 21st Century. Cluj-Napoca was also ranked in 2015 as the 57th top city to live in the world, according to Numbeo website.



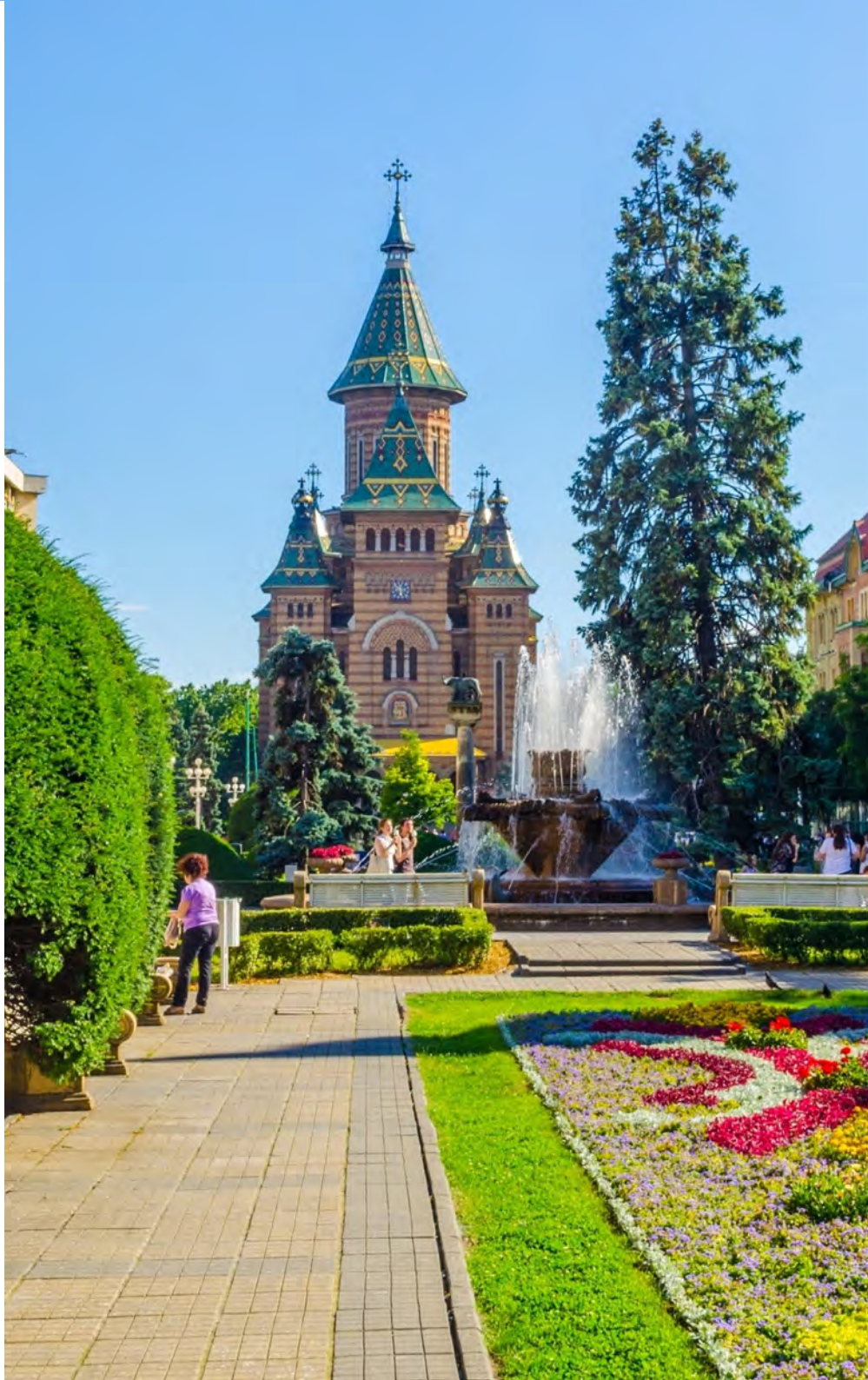
MAJOR CITIES

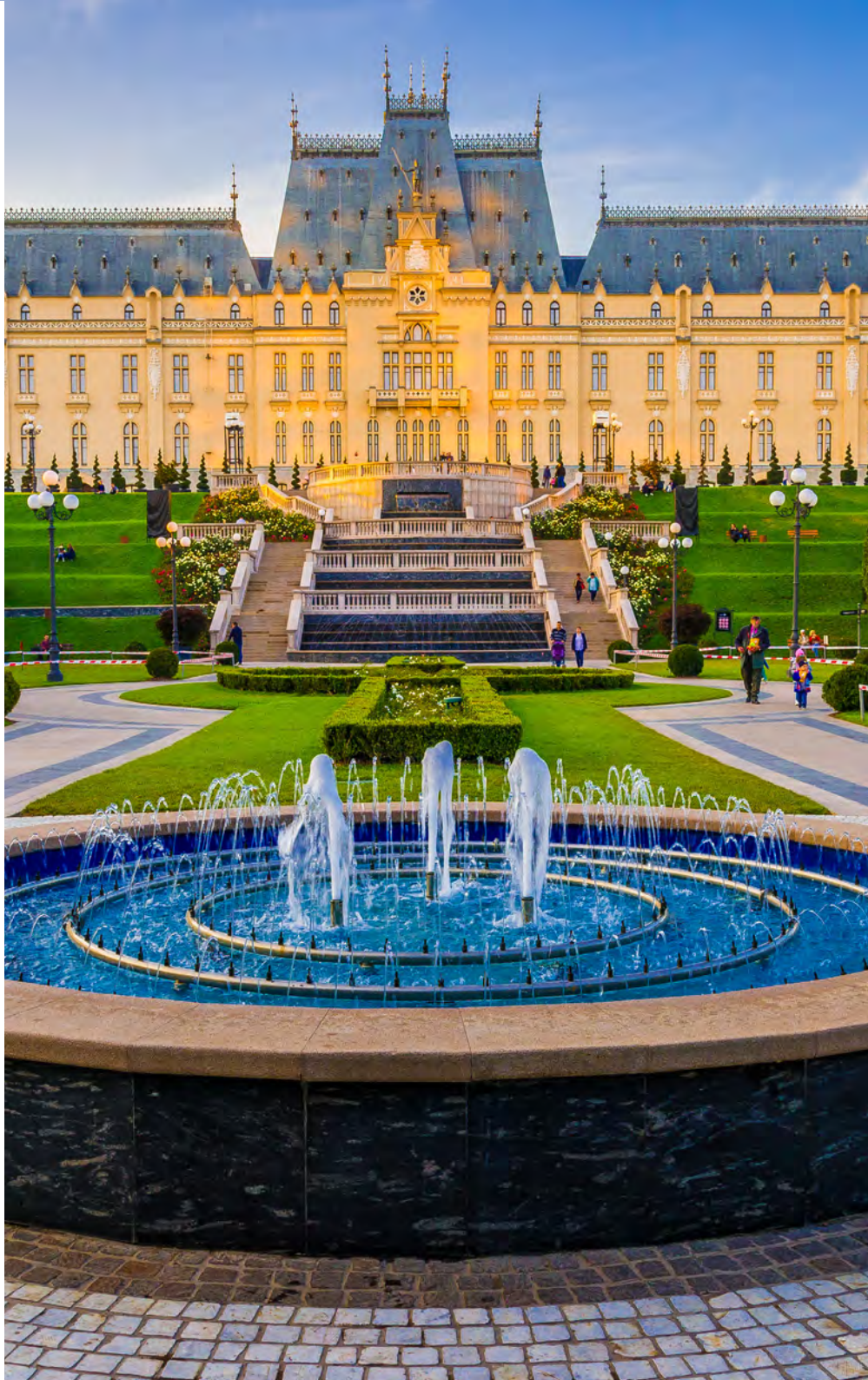


MAJOR CITIES

IAȘI

Gently spread on seven hills, Iași the former capital of Moldavia, is a charming city with broad boulevards and a rich artistic life.

Traces of its rich history and intense cultural life are visible in many areas of the city, but mostly in an impressive number of churches and monasteries, memorial houses and museums. Iași charms its visitors with its welcoming atmosphere, offering tourists the benefits of life in a city and the calm, soothing rhythms of a provincial town.



MAJOR CITIES

BRAȘOV

Brașov city (named "Kronstadt" in German aka "Crown City"), surrounded on three sides by mountains, was founded by the Teutonic Knights in 1211 on an ancient Dacian (Romanian ancestors) site.

It is a remarkable city which hosts Gothic, Baroque, Renaissance architecture, as well as other historical attractions. The marks of the Saxon heritage, are well preserved mainly in the Old Town.



Peleş Castle

Romania's most opulent palace, a masterpiece of German new-Renaissance architecture built between 1873-1914 for The Royal House of Romania.



Parliament Palace

Built in the 20th century in Bucharest, it is the second largest administrative building in the world after the Pentagon.



Bran Castle

Surrounded by an aura of mystery and legend, the medieval fortress owes its fame to its imposing appearance, as well as to the myth created around Bram Stoker's Dracula.



Voroneț Monastery (UNESCO World Heritage site)

Built in the 15th century, considered "The Sistine Chapel of the East", the monastery is renowned for its magnificent exterior frescoes.



Sighișoara fortress (UNESCO World Heritage site)

A beautiful, well-preserved medieval citadel, located in the heart of Transylvania, birthplace of Vlad 3rd the Impaler also known as Vlad Dracula.



Mocănița

It is the Romanian Narrow Gauge Steam Train that was born more than 100 years ago. Every morning the little train is going up in the forest bringing back loaded wagons.



Hunedoara Castle or Corvin Castle

One of the most important Gothic-Renaissance monument build in Romania.



Transfagarasan Alpine Road

Considered one of the most spectacular roads in the world, it is 90 km long and rises to a height of 2134 meters, challenging every driver with its sharp hairpin turns.



Turda Salt Mine

A veritable museum of salt mining in Transylvania.



Biertan fortified church (UNESCO World Heritage site)

An ecclesiastic and defense complex, built in 15th-16th centuries in late Gothic style, with specific Renaissance elements.



Bârsana Wooden church (UNESCO World Heritage site)

Located in the historical Maramureș region, this beautiful, unique wooden church was originally built in 1720.



Săpînța Merry Cemetery

Unique for its beautifully carved and brightly colored wooden headstones, depicting scenes from the life and occupation of the buried people.



Bigăr Waterfall

This beautiful and unique piece of nature, located in the Anina Mountains, has found itself on countless lists of stunning places around the world.



Alba Carolina medieval fortress

"The White Fortress" was built in the medieval city of Alba-Iulia, in the early 18th Century and it is considered to be the most representative of Vauban type in Europe.
